



QUARTER MIDGET RACING

Quarter Midget Racing is a Motor Sport-Racing program for children ages 5 to 16 years old. It is a sport that the entire family gets involved. The cars are 1/4-scaled Midget racecars. These cars feature fiberglass/aluminum bodies built around tubular chassis with fully integrated roll cages, adjustable independent suspensions, and are powered by high performance 4 cycle industrial engines. Tracks are made of concrete, asphalt, or dirt. Tracks are 1/20 of a mile in length. The Race season runs from March through November. This form of racing has been around for 70 years. Many successful drivers received their start in Quarter Midget series such as: Bobby & Terry Labonte, Tony Stewart, Mark Martin, and Jeff Gordon, just to name a few. Quarter Midget racing is very popular throughout North America with over 50 Quarter Midget club organizations and over 4,000 drivers. Admission is always free at all Quarter Midget tracks across the country. North Georgia Quarter Midget Association races are held at the Bill Thomas Raceway in Cumming, Georgia.
