

1.Registration will be from 8:30 to 10:00 a.m. on Saturday. If you have not registered at the close of registration, the driver will start in the rear of the field.

2.The race fee is \$30 per car which includes gas.

3.Make sure you bring either your 2010 badge or the gold copies that have been notarized or stamped with the QMA stamp.

4.You must have a safety inspection form for each car.

Safety inspections will be available on Friday night and Saturday morning.

5.The handler(s) and driver must register at the same time. Drivers are not allowed to sign themselves in nor can someone else sign in for you.

6.**IMPORTANT!!!**QMA requires both parents sign a Parental Waiver Release Form before a driver is allowed to race each year (This form will also have to be signed again at the States Race and at the Grands). You will also be required to sign this form at every other track you race at. In case a parent will not be at our 1st race, I am attaching the form to this email.

You can print this form and both parents sign it in front of a notary and bring it to registration or you can both sign it at registration in front of a NGQMA Board Member.

This strict rule is because QMA has had problems in the past when one of the parents had no idea their child was racing when with the other parent and problems arose. QMA is trying to prevent law suits and other problems for all their clubs. We want to make sure everyone can race and have fun this weekend so please make sure this form is filled out by both parents prior to the race and notarized or both parents are at registration.

7.Each driver must also sign the Minor Waiver Form (it is the 2nd page of the attachment). You can have them sign this prior to registration and you can sign as a witness if you would like. They can sign it at registration if you prefer.
