

## North Georgia Quarter Midget Association

### Meeting Minutes

April 6, 2009

#### **Opening:**

The regular meeting of the North Georgia Quarter Midget Association was called to order on April 6, 2009 by Tony Reid, club President.

Opening prayer was offered by Terry Mathis.

#### **A. Approval of Minutes**

The minutes of the March meeting were read by Sherry Taylor, seconded and approved as read.

#### **B. Approval of Financial Report**

The current financial report was read by Janis Thomas. Ending Balance was \$4,920.47. The report was seconded and approved as read.

#### **C. Old Business**

- \$1,500 was donated to Camp Kudzu for the charity race. Total collected was \$1,538.06. \$38.06 will stay in the bank account to keep it open.

#### **D. New Business**

The following items were voted on and approved by the club:

- Registration will be held from 9:00 to 10:00 on non-region races. Due to a low car count, the tower only needs one hour to register.
- The 2 hour lunch break was repealed. The length of the break is left up to the Race Director.
- When under caution, after the line-up is posted, there will be 10 laps to work on cars in the pits.
- Due to lack of volunteers to work as judges, the club voted to impose a penalty to the handlers who sign up to judge a race, then abandon their responsibility.: The first offense results in a 'judging penalty' which means the car(s) of the guilty party will start their next race in the rear of the field. The penalty for the second offense is that the car(s) of the offending party are DQ'd that day, and receive last place points.

#### **Other Updates:**

- Tony requested that the club supports the photographer and concession stand vendors.
- Tony also asked each person to think about they could do to make our club better.
- Apple Blossom – Trophies were changed by the Trophy Hut for no charge. The club will not provide gas. Track records will be open.
- All novices need a kill switch on top of the roll bar.
- Transponders must be in a bracket, not just Velcro or taped to the car.
- Troy Hickmon was appointed Race Director. Anyone has 30 days if they want to challenge for the position.
- The signs on the track fence in front of the registration building will be moved so that the judge's view is not impaired and people sitting in the registration building can still see the race.
