Opening:

The following items were voted on and approved by the club:

- Order 75 trophies for the Scorcher Region Race.
- There will be a \$25 charge for returned checks going forward. Tony will have a sign made to post in registration.
- Motion was made to require Raceceivers for novices at training and races. The club would purchase one radio and 4 Raceceivers (approximately \$500). Novices will purchase their own Raceceivers. It will be posted on the website so visitors know to bring ear buds.
- Future signs for the fence need to be 2x8 or 2x6 so spectators view of the track is not blocked.
- Bids were taken to repair steps leading to the tower for safety reasons. The \$450 bid by John Payne was accepted.
- Voted to buy 2 walls for the Nashville track.

Other Updates:

- State Farm donated \$500 on behalf of Kim Reid for donating her time to a non-profit organization.
- Friday, July 2nd we will have an exhibition race during the Cumming Fairgrounds fireworks. We will also participate in the parade on Saturday, July 3rd.
- The track photographers are not getting enough orders to support their website. We need to order pictures throughout the year. Suggestion was to ask them to wear a bright vest of something so they stand out.
- Tracy Taylor was asked to get an estimate for water diversion in the registration building. Also there needs to be some fence repair done before the next region race.
- Mr. Thomas reminded everyone that effective immediately no scooters, bikes etc... are allowed at the track any time. This includes training, practice and race day.
